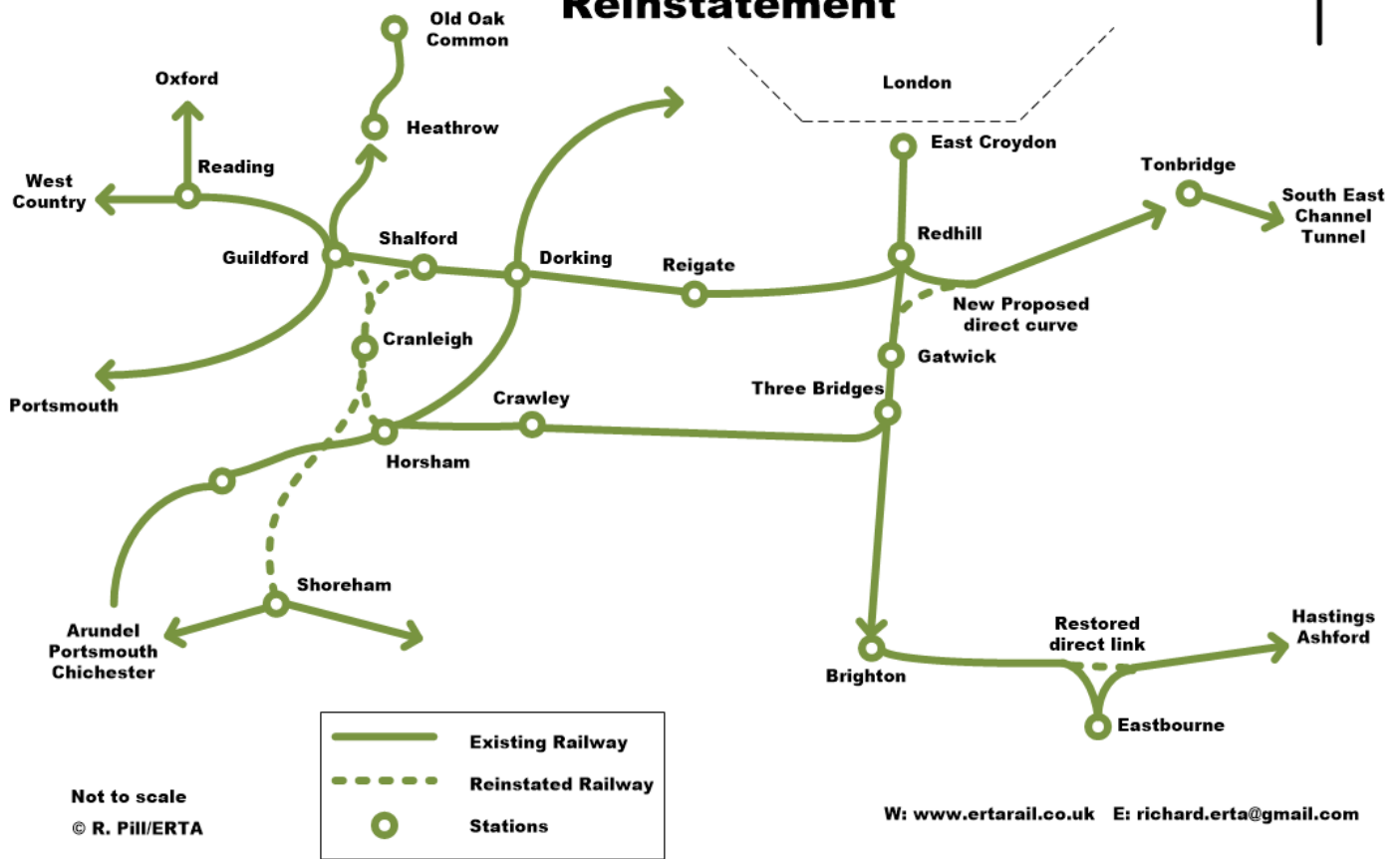
There is a strong need for the restoration of this local rail link, please help us by:

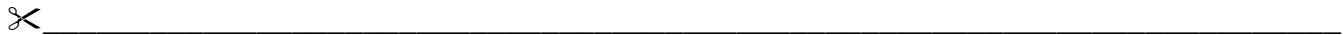
